- **REVIEW THE ENTIRE PACKET FIRST –** Create a timeline and prioritize!
- COMPLETE THE PACKET YOURSELF While your parents can proofread and guide you through the process, they CANNOT complete the packet for you.
- **COMPLETE ALL INFORMATION** Packets with missing, inaccurate or incomplete information may be cause for disqualification.
- NEATNESS COUNTS Attention to detail and your ability to follow directions will allow the faculty council to accurately evaluate your candidacy.
- ADVOCATE FOR YOURSELF All questions should be initiated by the candidate to the NJHS sponsor: Ms. Medina, <u>Imedina@lcisd.org</u>, room A120
- PROVIDE EVIDENCE Where possible, include COPIES of certificates, letters, awards or other forms of proof of service and leadership. Do not include originals- they will NOT be returned.
- MEET THE DEADLINES No candidate packets will be accepted after Friday, May 4th.

YOUR COMPLETED APPLICATION PACKET MUST BE SUBMITTED DIRECTLY TO MS. MEDINA (ROOM A120) NO LATER THAN FRIDAY, MAY 4TH AT 4:00PM. CANDIDATE PACKETS NOT RECEIVED BY THE DEADLINE WILL AUTOMATICALLY BE DISQUALIFIED.

Congratulations! You are eligible to apply for membership in the Lamar Junior High School Chapter of National Junior Honor Society. Membership in NJHS is one of the highest honors that can be awarded to a student. Our chapter strives to give practical meaning to the five pillars of NJHS: scholarship, leadership, service, citizenship, and character. The five pillars will be considered as the basis for your selection as well as a fundamental part of our chapter activities. The National Junior Honor Society strives to recognize the total student—one who excels in these areas. No student is inducted simply because of a high academic average. Please note that though you are eligible to apply, you have not been accepted into the organization yet. Applications must be reviewed by the NJHS Faculty Council to determine acceptance of new members.

If you are chosen to be inducted as a member of the Lamar Junior High School Chapter of the National Junior Honor Society, you must maintain the standards utilized for your selection. Please be aware that you:

- Must maintain a cumulative average of 85.0% in core subjects and have no failing final grades in any courses.
- Must abide by the Chapter's By-Laws and demonstrate sound and effective leadership, admirable citizenship, and trustworthy character.
- Pay the chapter dues of \$15 prior to second general NJHS meeting.
- Must be able to attend the monthly NJHS chapter meetings held after school on the first Monday of each month and must complete 10 service hours each semester.

Dismissal Procedures:

- May be dismissed from the chapter for failing to complete and to provide documentation of 10 hours of community service and school service *each semester*.
- May be dismissed or placed on probation for receiving a disciplinary referral.
- May be placed on probation for having unexcused absences from NJHS meetings-excuse note must be provided to advisor for consideration of absence.
- May be dismissed from the chapter for committing any offense classified by the LCISD Student Handbook or by having any documented incident of cheating and/or plagiarism.

EXPLANATION OF APPLICATION PACKET CONTENTS

This is the first step in your application process to be inducted as a member of the National Junior Honor Society. To be considered for membership, you must complete the following. Pay careful attention to instructions and deadlines. Students will be evaluated using the five pillars: *Scholarship, Service, Leadership, Character and Citizenship.*

Student Information Form. Write <u>neatly</u> in blue or black ink. This form will be kept as documentation for the 2018-19 school year and used for ordering shirts, field trips, email list, etc. This has proven to be essential in student safety. Please fill it out in its entirety.

SCHOLARSHIP: Students should maintain a cumulative average of 85 or higher in core subjects. Grades will be verified at the end of each six weeks. Attach a copy of your official 5th six weeks report card.

SERVICE: Service is one of the five pillars of NJHS. Provide proof of evidence as needed such as signatures, copies, etc. Service hours must be <u>unpaid volunteer hours</u> provided to the school or community outside of school hours. Service hours can be accumulated through organizations such as Common Threads, Lunches of Love, George Memorial Library, Ft. Bend Animal Shelter, local religious/ non-profit organizations.

LEADERSHIP: Leadership is one of the five pillars of NJHS. Leadership is not necessarily an elected position. Qualifying criteria include school or community leadership, school or community involvement in sports or extra-curricular activities. Provide proof of evidence as needed such as signatures, copies, etc.

CHARACTER & CITIZENSHIP: All students must maintain high standards of character and citizenship. The Faculty Council will consider teacher recommendations, evaluations and other relevant materials when evaluating a candidate for membership. The Faculty Council will also consider awards, recognitions, and work experience. Provide proof of evidence as needed.

Teacher Evaluations/Teacher Signature Form. Please allow your teachers time to complete this evaluation by giving it to them as soon as possible. **Don't procrastinate! Fill in any blanks on the forms before handing them out.** As you give each teacher your evaluation, ask him or her to sign and date the appropriate box on the Teacher Signature Form verifying that they received it. Teachers will submit the recommendation forms directly to us, so you will **not** include them in the packet you turn in to us; however, you will include the Teacher Signature Form in your packet for tracking purposes.

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Additional acceptable proof of Service, Leadership, Character and Citizenship may include:

Letter of Recommendation. This must be a one-page (250 words) maximum letter from an adult in the community who knows you well. The letter must include the person's phone number and must be signed. This letter cannot be written by a Lamar Junior High School staff member or one of your relatives. When requesting your letter, we recommend you ask the person to evaluate you on the five traits of NJHS: character, scholarship, leadership, service, and citizenship.

Subjective Letter. This letter must be neatly hand written or typed by the student in business letter format. This is a **one-page letter** (**250 words**) **maximum** in which you show how you currently represent the characteristics of NJHS— character, scholarship, leadership, service, and citizenship--and how you can use these qualities to contribute to the overall success of the organization.

Keep all completed application materials in one place. You will turn in all your paperwork together. Applications are due on or before <u>Friday, May 4, 2018</u>. Be sure to return your application directly to Ms. Medina. If you lose any of the pages, you may find them on our NJHS website: https://medinal.weebly.com/njhs.html

Make sure you follow all directions exactly and pay close attention to deadlines. If you do not turn in all pieces by these dates, then you will not be considered for membership. Good luck 3
